The Garratt St COVID Safety Plan – an important big step

The teams were involved in the final drafting, review and approval of The Garratt St Centre COVID Safety Plan. Thanks to the leaders who submitted plans for their specific ministry/activity that supplied details needed for this overall plan. These plans provide the assurance to the Leadership team that we have measures in place to provide an environment that is as COVID Safe as we can possibly make it.

Work in progress – baby steps

Because the plan is now in place, we are able to increase the number of people who can be on the property to 100 or 1 per 4 sqm — whichever is the lesser. In practical terms this means that we will be able to increase the number of activities and the number of people in activities that can happen, simultaneously, during the week.

It means we will be able to increase the number of volunteers doing jobs to reopen the building to full services and have the Op Shop open.

We are making steady progress on this long list of small jobs that need to be done before we can open our doors on a Sunday morning. We will be able to include more of the people who have indicated that they can help with the tasks. If you would like to be involved, please send a message to this email address.

Learning the COVID Safe behaviours – small steps

It is important that we learn, now, the behaviours of hand hygiene and distancing so that, if or when the virus is escalates, we will know how to behave to look after our own health and that of our neighbours. Many areas in the building are being taped out in 1.5 mt distances. This is an intentional step to help in this learning process.

<u>Our target reopening of Sunday services remains 13 September 2020</u>. However, times are as uncertain or more uncertain now than they have been as we prayerfully watch the escalation of the coronavirus in our neighbours of Victoria and New South Wales.

It's important to realise that this is a target only at this stage. We are working on the things that are in our control and praying on the things that are not. We must work, pray and wait and see.

Church services will continue to be recorded and posted on our website after we re-open so individuals may choose to continue to worship in the security of their own homes.

Last week's teaching on Wisdom is very pertinent this week as, on a daily basis we find that we need wisdom in making decisions and patience when we need to wait to find out more before the next decision can be made.

How comforting to know what to do – **Ask God** who gives generously.
