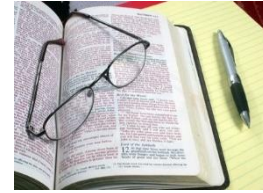

The College and its courses

Many Christians wish to go deeper in their knowledge of the Bible and their Christian faith, but do not have the time or financial capacity to attend a conventional Bible college and commit to formal study, assignments and assessments. Canberra Bible College aims to provide very affordable, live classes arranged in blocks with breaks for school holidays during Autumn and Spring over the two coming years. The College's courses are designed to cover (in a condensed and balanced, non-denominational manner) the main topics for the corresponding Morling College bachelors/masters units.

Attending the classes regularly will greatly enhance your knowledge and will earn you a Certificate of Attendance, but not formal credit towards a degree or diploma. Such credit would involve completion of written assignments and passing formal examinations. If you would like to gain formal credit towards a degree or diploma, you are encouraged also to enrol for the corresponding online courses with Morling College (Sydney). Attending the live classes here in Canberra as well as doing the online studies through Morling College would certainly increase your enjoyment of the overall learning experience.

The course "The Bible and What it Teaches"

The 2023-2024 course "The Bible and What it Teaches" is designed to give participants a comprehensive, working knowledge of the whole Bible and each of the major topics of Christian Theology. The course consists of 37 sessions in total spread over two years and covers the essential content of the 8 Morling College units OT001 (Old Testament Foundations) OT002 (Old Testament Prophets and Writings) NT001 (Jesus and the Gospels) NT002 (The early New Testament Church) TH001 (The Knowledge of God) TH003 (Grace and Eschatology) TH004 (The Church, Ministry and Sacraments) and TH008 (The Doctrine of God and Work of Christ).

The individual session topics are listed below. The related Morling College Old and New Testament unit numbers are indicated for each part of the course and students wishing to obtain formal credit are encouraged to enrol in those units.

The Lecturers

The principal lecturer for this course is Dr Raymond Wilson. He holds doctorates and other advanced degrees in science, biblical exposition and theology, is a retired scientist and associate professor, and has taught the Bible, Christian Theology and Apologetics in several Bible colleges and numerous churches for over 40 years.

Other experienced Bible teachers have also been invited to share in the delivery of the course.

Class times and format

Evening classes start promptly at 7:30pm and finish at (or very close to) 9:00 pm. Afternoon classes start promptly at 2:00 pm and finish at (or very close to) 3:30 pm. Classes include a 30-35-minute lecture/discussion session, followed by a break for refreshments, and then a further 30-35-minute lecture session.

Access and Parking

Access to the building is through the gates facing Garratt Street or through the walkway facing the Wanniasa Shopping Centre carpark. Ample, free car parking is available in the Garratt Street Centre forecourt and basement carparks and close nearby in the Wanniasa Shopping Centre carpark
